Subject: Consideration and/or Action adopting a resolution designating an engineering service provider to complete application and project related engineering services for the Texas Department of Agriculture's 2020 Texas Community Development Block Grant Downtown Revitalization/Main Street funding.

Background:

The 2020 TxCDBG Community Development Block Grant Downtown Revitalization/Main Street Fund contract requires implementation by professionals experienced in the administration of federally-funded community development projects. In order to identify qualified and responsive providers for these services a Request for Proposals (RFP) process for administration services and a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for engineering services has been completed in accordance with Texas CDBG requirements.

The proposals received by the due date have been reviewed to determine the most qualified and responsive providers for each professional service.

Recommendation: Council approve/accept professional services listed below:

Section 1. That KSA Engineers, Inc. be selected to provide Texas CDBG application and project-related professional engineering services for the 2020 Texas Community Development Block Grant Downtown Revitalization/Main Street Project.

Section 2. That any and all project-related services contracts or commitments made with the above-named service provider are dependent on the award of 2020 Texas Community Development Block Grant funds and successful negotiation of a contract with the service provider.
